Frequently Asked Questions

Can We Decorate the chapel?

ABSOLUTELY! Although not provided by us, the chapel can be decorated to suit your colour scheme or theme.

We would be happy to recommend local suppliers including Photographers, Florists, Event/Venue Dressing Specialists, and Wedding Planners if required.

Archways, Window ledges, Pew Ends and other areas may be dressed, provided no glue, staples, nails, Blu-tac etc. are used to attach anything to the walls.

It is worth noting that any damage created by decorations may incur a charge.





Can I set up the day before my wedding?

If there is no wedding or event booked for the day before your wedding, you are welcome to set up your wedding decorations. It can be confirmed if there is availability the day before your wedding two months prior to your wedding date.

Can we use candles?

Yes, non-drip candles are permitted with bases or holders.





Can we have Confetti, Fireworks or Chinese Lanterns?

As the Chapel is also used for other types of service, unfortunately, we are unable to allow the use of Confetti (or anything similar) on the site. Sorry, Fireworks and Chinese Lanterns are not permitted either.

Could a marquee be considered?

Unfortunately, we are not able to allow marquees in the grounds.

Is there a music system?

Yes, a music system is available, along with microphones for the Ceremony if required. We also find that our Bluetooth speaker is perfect for the space.

Is parking available?

Limited parking is available for vehicles during set up and clearing up periods, prior to and after the service. Parking is available for the duration of the service for Bridal Cars. Limited Disabled Parking is available. We are very fortunate to have a public car park situated next to the chapel.

Is there Wi-Fi at Barnoon Chapel?

Yes, complimentary Wi-Fi can be provided if required.



Can we hire The Porthmeor Suite?

Yes, of course, however this comes at an additional charge. This space is ideal for a small gathering prior to the Ceremony or as a place to hold an afternoon tea or small buffet after the service.



Can we have a Disco in The Porthmeor Suite?

Unfortunately, this is not an ideal space for a larger wedding reception or party. However, we would be happy to recommend local alternatives for you to consider for your Wedding Reception.

You could certainly enjoy playing some music during your gathering here though. We do like to keep on the good side of our neighbours and local community so we would not allow late night gatherings.



How do we pay?

We ask for a 25% booking Fee, and the balance to be paid two months before your wedding.



Can we provisionally hold a date?

Yes, it is free of charge to hold a date, and there is no obligation to book! Dates can be provisionally held for up to one week, or until someone else is interested in the same date.

Can we pay for our wedding in instalments?

Yes, we can be flexible with payment terms, so please do speak to us about your requirements.

Can we hire the Chapel with our own Celebrant?

Sorry, the Chapel is only available exclusively with The Registrar. The fee for the Registrar is additional and payable directly to them and not included.
